## Mornington Peninsula Attractions

### Things to do

- ⇒ **Peninsula Hot Springs** - Natural thermal mineral waters flow into the pools and private baths providing the idyllic setting for relaxation and rejuvenation. Peninsula Hot Springs makes it possible to bathe in the naturally healing waters of mineral rich thermal pools.
- ⇒ **Beaches** - The Mornington Peninsula is home to some of the most stunning beaches in Australia from calm bay beaches to rugged and breathtaking ocean beaches.
- ⇒ **McClelland Sculpture Park & Gallery** - provides a wonderful adventure featuring over 100 sculptures on 16 hectares of native bushland and landscaped gardens, art gallery, licenced café and gift shop.

### Day Trips

- ⇒ **Sunny Ridge Strawberry Farm** where visitors can pick fresh berries. Has a gift shop and cafe with home-made wine and liqueurs. Farm facts, strawberry growing hints and folklore.
- ⇒ **Head to the beach** Roll out your towel on the golden shores of Port Phillip Bay. The long, wide bay beaches at Frankston are ideal for swimming, snorkelling and yachting. Small bays are dotted between Mount Eliza and Mornington, while a series of safe, sandy bay beaches can be found around Mount Martha.
- ⇒ **Cape Schanck Lighthouse** The Cape Schanck Lighthouse is a fascinating piece of Victoria's history. The museum and lighthouse are open to the public every day for tours. Nearby walking tracks in the Mornington Peninsula National Park lead to lookouts with spectacular views of the coast.

### Food, Wine & Nightlife

- ⇒ **Sip local wine and craft beer** The Mornington Peninsula is home to more than 50 cellar doors. Pinot noir and chardonnay are the region's specialties, however shiraz, pinot gris and pinot grigio are beginning to share the spotlight.
- ⇒ **Main Ridge Dairy** Farmhouse cheese factory and goat dairy, offering a true paddock to plate experience.
- ⇒ **Green Olive** Green Olive at Red Hill is a whole farm experience. They grow olives, grapes, herbs and veggies, raise sheep and cooks as well as use fresh produce from local farmers to create a range of tapas and wine you will love.

### Shopping

- ⇒ **Main Street Mornington** a whole kilometre of cosmopolitan boutique shopping, with more than 370 retail outlets to explore.
- ⇒ **Melbourne** head into the big smoke for a day out at the shops!

### Important Information

Our tours are contingent on sufficient bookings. If tours don't proceed due to a lack of bookings a full refund will be paid.

Bookings are required 30 days prior to departure, late bookings will be considered (a surcharge may apply).

Players to provide own golf clubs/shoes.

All golf levels are welcome but players are recommended to have an official handicap as some golf courses may request proof.

If you wish to book your own airfares, please advise and we will provide the reduced tour cost. Transfers to and from the airport will be your own responsibility.

## Terms and Conditions

### Bookings

To secure your reservation you will need to provide a \$500 deposit per person and also complete the booking form. Note: The deposit becomes non-refundable as soon as flights are booked.

### Travel Insurance

Taking out travel insurance is an absolute must have and you should arrange this at time of booking the tour. We have arrangements with travel insurance companies at great rates, hence please contact us if you require a travel insurance quote.

### Visas / Passports

To travel your New Zealand passport needs to valid for at least 6 months from tour end date. If travelling on a foreign passport we can assist with your visa requirements. Note: It is your responsibility to ensure you have valid travel documents in order to travel on the tour.

### Cancellations/Refunds

If the tour has to be cancelled due to a lack of numbers your deposit will be refunded in full. If you cancel your booking:

- Prior to flights being booked a full refund will be paid
- Between 30—60 days of tour departure - 50% refund
- Within 30 days of tour departure - no refund
- Note: it is imperative that you take out travel insurance at time of booking in case of sickness or other issues that prevents your from travelling.

### Travel Documentation

Your travel documentation will be issued 20 days prior to departure.

### Tour Flexibility
